



AGREEMENT on COOPERATION

Between

Ara Institute of Canterbury, Christchurch, New Zealand And

Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon, Thailand

The Ara Institute of Canterbury (Ara), Christchurch, New Zealand and Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon, Thailand, (RMUTP), wishing to establish an institutional relationship, agree to cooperate with each other as follows:

Scope of the Cooperation

Subject to mutual consent, the areas of cooperation will include any of the activities listed below. Both parties will contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two institutions.

Cooperation shall be carried out through such activities as:

- 1. Exchange of faculty and/or students
- II. Joint research activities and publications
- III. Participation in seminars and academic meetings
- IV. Exchange of academic materials and other information
- V. Special short-term academic programs for groups of students
- VI. Semester study abroad programs

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this Agreement on Cooperation shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such agreements entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this Agreement on Cooperation. Each institution shall designate a liaison person to develop and coordinate the specific activities agreed upon. This agreement will remain in place for a period of five years effective from the date of signing. With the mutual consent of both parties, this agreement may be extended for an additional five years. A minimum period of six months' notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the Agreement. In the event of termination, all commitment to students participating in the programme will be honoured by the relevant parties.
