



## Memorandum of Understanding



Between

**Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon (RMUTP), Thailand**

And

**Anshan Normal University (ANU), P.R. China**

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This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and executed by and between Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon (RMUTP), is a public university located in Bangkok, where under the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research, and Innovation, Thailand, which located at 399 Samsen Road, Vachira Phayaban, Dusit, Bangkok, Thailand, represented by its President Dr. Natworapol Rachsirivatcharabul, duly authorized, hereinafter referred to as 'RMUTP',

and

Anshan Normal University (ANU), a public university in the People's Republic of China offering higher education courses, approved by the Ministry of Education as the University for Cultivating International Students for Chinese Government Scholarships, which located at 43 Ping'an Street, Tiedong District, Anshan, Liaoning, 114007, P.R.China, represented by its President Liu Gengwei, duly authorized, hereinafter referred to as 'ANU'

### **1. Objective**

This MOU focuses on strengthening educational, cultural, and academic exchanges between Anshan Normal University (ANU), P.R. China and Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon (RMUTP), Thailand through the forms such as student and teachers exchange, and academic conference of both parties.

### **2. Areas of Cooperation**

Both parties will encourage and promote co-operation in the following areas:

#### 2.1 Exchange of students

Both parties can send their students to other party for exchange study.

#### 2.2 Exchanges of teachers

Both parties can send teachers to other parties to give lectures to other party

#### 2.3 Participation in academic conferences

Both parties may jointly hold or participate in academic conferences.

### **3. Responsibilities of the Parties**

#### **3.1 Responsibilities of RMUTP**

RMUTP will support and actively promote activities of exchange students and teachers, participate in academic conferences, and exchange of academic materials as outlined in areas of cooperation of this MOU.

#### **3.2 Responsibilities of ANU**

ANU will support and actively promote activities of exchange students and teachers, participate in academic conferences, and exchange of academic materials as outlined in areas of cooperation of this MOU.

### **4. Expenditures and Budgetary**

Both parties agree that expenditures which may be incurred during the period of implementing this Memorandum of Understanding, the parties shall enter into discussions and negotiate case by case.

### **5. Effect of Memorandum of Understanding**

This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a record of the parties' cooperative intentions and does not constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

### **6. Confidentiality**

Each party shall undertake to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from or supplied to, the other party during the period of the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding or any other agreements made pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding.

### **7. Revision, Modification and Amendment**

Either party may request in writing a revision, modification or amendment of all or any part of this Memorandum of Understanding within thirty (30) days prior to the mutual negotiation with the other party. Any revision, modification or amendment agreed to by the parties will be reduced into writing and will form part of this Memorandum of Understanding and come into force on such date as may be determined by both parties.

### **8. Termination**

Either party may terminate this MOU by providing written notice of such termination to the other party within sixty (60) days prior to the date of termination. In the case of such termination, any activities currently underway shall be allowed to continue until their conclusion.

## **9. Duration**

The term of this agreement shall be from the date of signing of the agreement and will remain in effect for five (5) years.
