MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING Between

IN ORDER to promote co-operation between Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon (RMUTP) and Tallinna Tehnikakõrgkool University of Applied Sciences (TTK), the main contents are as follows:

To the extent feasible, both Institutes will encourage direct contact and co-operation between their faculty members, departments, and schools.

The two Institutes will endeavor to co-operate in education and research areas of mutual interest. Within fields that are mutually acceptable, the following general forms of co-operation will be pursued:

- 1. Student and staff exchanges
- 2. Staff development: training and further study
- 3. Co-research projects
- 4. Visiting lecturers

Themes of joint activities and the most appropriate way of utilizing the results achieved, arrangement for specific visits, exchanges, and other forms of co-operation will be developed mutually in each specific instance.

Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

HEREUPON the signatures of the representative of both Institutes will follow in the hope of promoting mutual friendship and co-operation. The MOU will remain in effect until one part notifies the other of its wish to terminate the MOU at least ninety (90) days before the end of the academic year.
