The purpose of this memorandum of understanding is to create academic collaboration between Amasya University and Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon (hereafter referred to as RMUTP).

#### Rationale for the Partnership

RMUTP strives to be a leading technology university in producing professional graduates and to be recognized internationally. The National Education Act B.E. 2542 (1999) of Thailand focuses on the development and collaboration between government and private sectors locally and internationally in order to create efficient education in the age of globalization.

Amasya University is a higher education institution seeking collaborating between institutions in the scope of Mevlana Exchange Programme. Student and academic staff Exchange will be undertaken to concur with the principles and conditions set forth in Mevlana Exchange Programme and accomplish the exchange in compliance with activities and numbers of students/academic staff and in line with "Higher Education Law (No: 2547)", "Regulation on Mevlana Exchange Programme" (No: 28034 – Date: 23 August 2011) and "Principles and Procedures on Use, Accounting of the Amounts to be Transferred to Higher Education Institutions and Other Relevant Matters On the Payments to Be Made in the Scope of Mevlana Exchange Programme" of Mevlana Exchange Programme.

### **Expectations and Areas for Collaboration**

This agreement between Amasya University and RMUTP is made to be mutually beneficial to both institutions and their stakeholders. The following areas of focus are considered to

have the most importance and potential for furthering the partnership endeavor between the two institutions.

- Student and faculty exchange programmes
- Arts and cultural exchange programmes
- Sharing of "best practices"
- Other areas to be determined

As specific initiatives are undertaken pursuant to this agreement, contracts and/or letters of clarification shall be developed, approved and signed by all parties before action is taken depending on the nature of the initiative.

This Memorandum of Understanding is effective upon approval of both parties to the terms of the agreement as evidenced by signature and will continue for a period of five years. If one party wishes to exit from the said agreement, a written notice is requested at least six months prior to the planned termination date.
