





MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon, Bangkok, Thailand

And

Green Energy Equity Investment Co., Ltd., P.R. China

And

Fire Empowerment Co., Ltd., Thailand

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and executed by and between Rajamangala University of Technology Phra Nakhon (RMUTP), is a public university located in Bangkok, where under the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research, and Innovation, Thailand, which located at 399 Samsen Road, Vachira Phayaban, Dusit, Bangkok, Thailand, represented by its President Dr. Natworapol Rachsiriwatcharabul, duly authorized, hereinafter referred to as "RMUTP",

and

Green Energy Equity Investment Co.,Ltd., a China company registered in accordance with P.R. China Laws, under Commercial Registration No. 91350200MA3492CH63, with its main office located at Room 811, Taixiang Building, Siming District, Xiamen City, 361001, P.R. China., represented by its President, Dr. Lin Huan-Ku, duly authorized, hereinafter referred to as "GEEI".

and

Fire Empowerment Co.,Ltd., a Thai company registered in accordance with Thailand Civil and Commercial Laws, Registration No. 0125565032139, with its main office located at 160/196, ITF Silom Palace Building, 13th Floor, Silom Road, Suriyawong, Bangrak, Bangkok 10500, Thailand, represented by its Partner, Ms. Apichchaya Thepsothon, duly authorized, hereinafter referred to as "FEP".

The parties shall hereinafter individually be referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

1. Objective

This MOU focuses on strengthening academic collaboration in the development of non-toxic environmental fire prevention products and exchanging knowledge of safety innovation and technologies through joint research initiatives and academic services.

2. Area of Cooperation

- 2.1 Exchange of staff and researchers
- 2.2 Joint research and smart solutions development of innovative technologies for fire prevention.
- 2.3 Academic services through exchange knowledge and research in each party's expertise.
 - 2.3 Exploring opportunities for staff development: training and official visit.

3. Responsibilities of the Parties

3.1 Responsibilities of RMUTP

- 3.1.1 Share RMUTP expertise in research and innovation.
- 3.1.2 Provide all necessary information, documents, and further necessary assistance that are required by GEEI and FEP as well as any additional support RMUTP is able and willing to provide.
- 3.1.3 Provide for training or workshop arrangement that are required by GEEI and FEP as well as RMUTP is able and willing to provide.
- 3.1.4 Allow GEEI and FEP to enter and visit facilities which relate to any activities under this MOU.
- 3.1.5 Register the products under National Science and Technology Development Agency (NSTDA) and National Innovation Agency (NIA), Thailand.

3.2 Responsibilities of GEEI

- 3.2.1 Share GEEI expertise and exchange knowledge, including facilities, materials, tools and equipment in the development of non-toxic environmental fire prevention products and safety innovation and technologies.
- 3.2.2 Provide all necessary information, documents, and further necessary assistance that are required by RMUTP and FEP as well as any additional support GEEI is able and willing to provide.

- 3.2.3 Provide for training or workshop arrangement that are required by RMUTP and FEP as well as GEEI is able and willing to provide.
- 3.2.4 Allow RMUTP and FEP to enter and visit facilities which relate to any activities under this MOU.

3.3 Responsibilities of Fire Empowerment Co. Ltd.

- 3.3.1 Share FEP expertise and exchange knowledge, including facilities, materials, tools and equipment in the development of non-toxic environmental fire prevention products and safety innovation and technologies.
- 3.3.2 Provide all necessary information, documents, and further necessary assistance that are required by RMUTP and GEEI as well as any additional support FEP is able and willing to provide.
- 3.3.3 Provide for training or workshop arrangement that are required by RMUTP and GEEI as well as FEP is able and willing to provide.
- 3.3.4 Allow RMUTP and GEEI to enter and visit facilities which relate to any activities under this MOU.

4. Expenditures and Budgetary

Any expenditures which may incurred under section 2 Area of Cooperation, each party shall bear its own costs and must comply with the Rules of Thailand's Ministry of Finance on the Expenditures of International Training, Events, and Conferences or Revenue and Expenditures Guidance of RMUTP.

5. Nature of Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a record of parties' intentions and does not constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied. Notwithstanding the terms "Parties" and "Partnership", the Parties agree that they are not entering into, joint venture or any other such business arrangement and are independent parties.

6. Confidentiality

Each Party shall undertake to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from or supplied to, the other Party during the period of the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding or any other agreements made pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding.

7. Revision, Modification, and Amendment

Either Party can request in writing a revision, modification or amendment of all or any part of this Memorandum of Understanding at least thirty (30) days prior to the mutual negotiation with the other party. Any revision, modification or amendment agreed to by the Parties will be made into writing or intent letter which will be formed to be a part of this Memorandum of Understanding and come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties.

8. Termination

Either Party may terminate this MOU by providing written notice of such termination to the other Party at least sixty (60) days prior to the date of termination by the approval of the other party. In the case of such termination, any activities currently underway shall be allowed to continue until their conclusion.

9. Duration

The term of this agreement shall be from the date of signing of the agreement and will remain in effect for three (3) years.
